WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

How to obtain a working with children check:

Coaches, Managers and other persons (aged 18+) working or volunteering with children (u18) must now apply for a Working with Children Check (WWCC) and obtain a working with children check number. This is a NSW Government requirement.

Exemptions: The following are exempt from the WWCC requirements:

- Persons under 18 years of age
- Grounds persons
- Guest presenters or speakers for a one-off presentation
- Persons who work or volunteer with children visiting NSW from another State to attend an event where the work in NSW will be for no more than 30 days in a calendar year.

**If you are not within the exempt categories listed above then you
DO need a WWCC as follows:**

Application Process

1. Complete the WWCC application form on-line (volunteer or paid depending on your role within the club) and receive your application number.
2. Take your application number, proof of ID and \$80 (NO cost if volunteer) to a Roads and maritime service (RMS) registry.
3. The RMS will issue you with a receipt.
4. You should receive your WWCC Number by email within approximately 10 days.
5. **THEN** provide your WWCC Number to your club- the Child safety officer via asmelchior@bigpond.com or sms 0412334192 and please include your full name and DOB along with the WWCC number/application number.
